

# Fast Winn Photography Appointment Check List

I have prepared the list below so that when I arrive for your photo session we can get to work on capturing the perfect photos that you deserve. This session may be 1 ½ to 2 hours long so make sure that you don't have anything else scheduled that would interfere. We will start the session by checking out good sites for backgrounds and getting to know you and your horse(s).

**1. What type of photos do you want? Please check all that apply**

**2. Is there a special location you want to use for a background?**

**3. Are you OK with your horse getting treats, if so what is OK? Carrots, apples, Bermuda pellets? I like to bring some carrots to give the horses and have some cool shots with horses eating carrots out of cowboy hats...no worries I will bring an old hat for this.**

**4. Is there a type of portrait you want? A photo or picture you saw that you want to duplicate? Do you want a photo of you putting on the horse's bridle, riding bareback, lounging?**

**5. Please have your horse groomed for the photo session. Provide some brushes and a cleaning rag so we can clean up the horses during the photo session.**

**6. If you are going to have photos with your horse saddled please make sure the tack and saddle blanket are clean and photo ready.**

**7. If you are going to be in the photos please be sure your clothing is clean, ironed if needed and that your boots are polished. Wear a solid colored shirt that isn't too bright a color. I recommend that you wear a shirt with soft colors. White shirts are OK but hard to capture in detail and around horses can get dirty.**

**8. Please rate your horse's tolerance for new things. We use a reflector to get the light on you and your horse if needed. We also use some gentle noise makers to get your horse's attention and ears forward.**
